

Safety Rules

Each event will begin with a safety briefing and equipment demonstration.

- Good manners are expected from all participants at Flashpoint Lasertag events
- Players are not allowed to leave the designated playing area with equipment.
- Players must not aim at or engage with bystanders outside of the playing area.
- Players are not allowed within 6 feet of each other using the equipment; the aggressor is required to retreat or be ejected from the game.
- Shoes are required...no open toe sandals, bare feet, flip-flops or crocs.
- No foul or abusive language will be tolerated. Offenders will be removed from the event.
- Physical or verbal threats against another player will result in an ejection from the game.
- No food or drink around the equipment. Players who decide to partake in refreshments must dispose of any trash in trash bins. Any littering will result in the player being expelled from the event.
- Players are not allowed to fire taggers while reaching around an obstacle from a hidden position.
- Players are forbidden to trample flower beds, disturb fixtures or otherwise make any alteration to objects found in the play area. Offenders will be warned once and thereafter expelled from the event.
- Players are not allowed to crawl under obstacles. In addition, climbing trees or buildings is strictly forbidden.
- No barrel rolls, superman dives, or other intentionally unsafe action movie activity (do not jump over obstacles).
- Players cannot cover sensors with their hands or clothing (strategic use of cover such as terrain, trees or buildings is allowed)
- Head sensors must be properly worn and must be properly adjusted if they fall off during the game (the headband is not a necklace)
- Unsafe behavior will be identified and corrected by the game Operator; repeat offenders will be ejected from the game.
- No intentional abuse of the equipment; please help keep our equipment in good working order. Breaking our equipment will incur charges.

Related Information:

- Customers are responsible for selecting a safe location
- Game Operators are responsible for identifying and marking off or removing potential safety hazards, as well as informing the customer
- The designated playing area will be clearly defined to ensure that all players are safe and easily identified as players in a game
- No players under the age of 8, or by the discretion of the Game Operator, will be allowed to use the taggers to avoid impact injuries
- Game Operators will not be penalized for enforcing the safety rules; safety is our number one priority
- The Game Operator has the right to terminate any engagement due to unsafe conditions
 like unexpected and unavoidable hazards, inclement weather, the presence of illegal drugs,
 excessive alcohol use, injury to a guest, abusive player activity, etc.
- Our equipment is 100% safe to operate but to avoid injuries we need to prevent collisions and falls. Treat each other with respect and stay within the playing area.

Park Specific Information

- Admiralty House
 - 1. Game play to only take place in the lower park area. The derelict building is off limits and the whole area should be avoided to prevent possible injury to guests.
 - 2. Tennis court area is off limits, and guests are not allowed to enter it for any reason
 - 3. Tunnel is off limits, and guests should not enter for any reason
 - 4. Electrical substation is off limits. Advise quests to avoid the area.

Arboretum

- 1. No game play in the parking lot or near rest facilities.
- 2. Flower garden with white rock path is off limits to all game play. Players need to be warned to stay out of the area to avoid damage to the environment. Cones must also be placed to show areas off limits.
- 3. No game play in the back trails, especially for younger guests.
- 4. No game play on the small bridge area in the Eastern part of the park.
- 5. Guests are to stay out of all areas marked as private property, including the Parks Department depot on the hill.



• Fort Scaur

- 1. Game play only allowed in Scaur Hill Park. The fort itself is off limits to laser tag. Guests may only enter the fort area to use the rest facilities, and they must leave their equipment with the operator before doing so.
- 2. The cell tower and adjacent facility are off limits to all laser tag players.
- 3. Warn players about the drop in the center of the park.

COVID19 Requirements

Flashpoint Lasertag will observe the following:

- All gear is wiped down and sanitized prior to and following each event.
- We will be using a combination of disinfectant and UV light to keep gear clean.
- All headbands provided to the players are single-use and will be laundered with soap and hot water after each session.
- Until further notice, no more than 20 players may participate in the events.
